The institute called the advertisement for filing the post of the Registrar on Deputation or on Contract. The incumbent Registrar applied through proper channel by clearly mentioning the mode of recruitment as 'Deputation'. While issuing the Appointment Letter - The SPA did not mention the mode of recruitment as 'Deputation' which was an error, which may be rectified by even issuing a corrigendum/clarification, if required. As he has applied on 'Deputation',	
	his case of Transfer TA was approved by the BoG. As he has applied on 'Deputation' he cannot stay on the post of Registrar-SPA for a period more than as allowed as per his Normal Superannuation Time in Parent Organization. So on last days of his service, he needs to be repatriated back to his parent organization. From where he will get retired as per the Superannuation age applicable in his parent department.
