Minutes of Fifth Academic Council meeting

The Chairman, Academic Council / Director I/c welcomed all the members and initiated discussion on the agenda items, during the discussion the members of Academic Council expressed / advised the following:

- 1) Dr Partha Mukhopadhyay enquired the very necessity of Course Equivalence Scheme when the students detained from the old scheme can otherwise be offered to study subjects as per new scheme. The Head, Department of Architecture, explained that owing to the differences in the structural, sequence as well as content between old scheme and new scheme, evolving the course equivalence scheme was inevitable.
- 2) Director I/c, Prof Dr Atiya Habeeb Kidwai and Ar. Atul Gupta expressed their concern over the availability of faculty and resources adequate to handle the special classes as necessary in case of a few subjects where equivalent subject is not available or partially available. The Head, Department of Architecture and the special invitees expressed that they are aware of the difficulties in implementing the CES but at the same time in absence of a better alternative, CES emerged as a necessity. Also, the Head, Department of Architecture, added saying that this is one of the reasons to propose additional supplementary examination attempts to be given for old scheme students so as to apply CES as the last resort.
- 3) Thus and in continuation to the above, Director I/c advised that a provision to clear / pass credits of failed subjects may be made through extra classes in the vacation, may be made as an amendment to the Semester Credit pattern exam rules. Understandably, this is the practice followed across reputed institutions of the World in the Credit System of curriculum. Also, enabling such practice shall prevent year loss for students as otherwise.
- 4) Upon working out the above, the revised scheme may be put up for the approval of the Council in its next meeting.

During the Academic Council meeting the following items were also discussed:

- 1) Prof. Dr. Atiya Habeeb Kidwai raised the context of Andhra Pradesh Capital Development wherein there shall be lot of transformation in the Human Settlements from present to future.
 - In this regard, Prof. Dr. Atiya Habeeb Kidwai, Dr. Partha Mukhopadhyay and the Director I/c / Chairman, Academic Council advised SPA, Vijayawada to document the development process as far as possible so as to, keep a record of the transformation of human settlements, land form and the capital region as a whole.
 - Director I/c emphasized the importance of documentation in general and stressed the need for documenting, transformation of A.P. Capital area in particular.
- 2) Dr Partha Mukhopadhyay suggested that SPA, Vijayawada may plan an active role in the ongoing process of A.P. Capital Development, in the form of advisory, evaluation, design development and / or policy making.

The Head, Department of Architecture / Dean of Studies and the Head, Department of Planning informed the Council that SPA, Vijayawada is already playing active part (in various capacities viz., intellectual, advisory, guidance, evaluation etc.,) in the A.P. Capital Development process.

The Council appreciate and acknowledged the same.
